### Selected New Books in The Americas Collection

The NLU Library's The Americas Collection is a collection of bilingual, Spanish and Latino themed childrens and young adult books. This collection has been developed in conjunction with the Center for Teaching through Children's Books and is housed at the Lisle Campus Library.

Through a grant from the American Library Association Free Pass Program, Ruth Quiroa, Assistant Professor, Reading & Language Center, NCE, and Barbara Evans, Librarian, Lisle Campus Library, attended the Feria Internacional de Libro de Guadalajara in November 2008, an impressive international book fair, and purchased enough books to double the size of this collection to approximately 700 items. The criteria for the books purchased were: originally published in Spanish; written by Latin American authors and, for the most part, published in Latin American countries
